

Parish Report for 2024

Heavy rains in February showed that work done by the Highways Authority to clear drains had been successful; water flowing down Hall Road caused no flooding, as it had four months before on 20th October. But by the end of the year, the culvert at the bottom of The Gull still had not been cleared.

Weather was not on the farmers' side: crops suffered from not being drilled the previous autumn; sown in spring, the summer was cool and yields were down by a quarter of a ton per acre.

The Old Schoolhouse, a central feature in village history, came on the market and had not sold by the end of the year. Bar nights at the Village Hall became a regular monthly event, food supplied admirably by Sandra Poacher.
